Les Grosses têtes est la suite d'un projet partageant le même nom. Quatre jeunes artistes Autochtones et Métis créeront quatre nouvelles têtes représentant leur culture, guidés par un artiste francophone et un artiste Autochtone professionnels. Les quatre nouvelles Grosses têtes seront ensuite inaugurées pendant les festivités des Alberta Culture Days, et paradés avec les sept Grosses têtes existantes. Nous souhaitons illustrer les différences et similarités entre nos cultures et les rapprocher en créant des oeuvres d'art collectifs qui représentent notre connexion et nos valeurs partagées.

The Grosses têtes (Big Heads) is a continuation of a previous project by the same name. Four Indigenous and Métis youth are creating four new Heads representing Indigenous cultures under the mentorship of a Francophone professional artist and an Indigenous professional artist. The four new Big Heads will be inaugurated during the Alberta Culture Days and paraded along with the 7 previously created Big Heads. We strive to illustrate differences and similarities between our communities and bring them closer together by collectively creating art that represents our connection and celebrates our shared values.

Featuring one Francophone and two Indigenous artists, this panel discussion will focus on culture, personal experiences and stories, and will be followed by a question period. During the panel, the panelists will facilitate an art workshop in which participants will create a collaborative art piece inspired by the emotions they experienced during the discussion.
